

Essential Qualification for the Post of TGT :

(1) TGT Punjabi

- (i) Graduate or its equivalent from recognized University with Punjabi as an elective subject with at least 50% marks.
- (ii) Bachelor of Education Degree recognized by NCTE with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent with Punjabi as teaching subject.
- (iii) Pass in Teacher Eligibility test (TET) conducted by the CBSE New Delhi in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE is compulsory.

(2) TGT Sanskrit

- (i) Graduate or its equivalent from recognized University with Sanskrit as an elective subject with at least 50% marks.
- (ii) Bachelor of Education Degree recognized by NCTE with at least 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent with Sanskrit as teaching subject.
- (iii) Pass in Teacher Eligibility test (TET) conducted by the CBSE New Delhi in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE is compulsory.

Essential Qualification for the Post of JBT

- (A) (i) Graduate or its equivalent from a recognized University.
- (ii) Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El. Ed.) (by whatever name known) of not less than 02 years duration recognized by NCTE.
- (iii) Pass in Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by CBSE New Delhi applicable for the teachers teaching class I to V in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE.

OR

- (B) (i) Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B. Ed.)
- (ii) Pass in Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by CBSE New Delhi applicable for the teachers teaching class I to V in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE.

Note : Candidates who have acquired the qualification of Bachelor of Education from any NCTE recognized institution shall be considered for appointment as a teacher in classes I to V provided the person so appointed as a teacher shall mandatorily undergo a six month Bridge Course in Elementary Education recognized by the NCTE, within two years of such appointed as primary teacher.
